Mr. Ritter:


In response to your electronic mail requesting additional copies of the July 12, 2011, BOS public meeting, please be advised that RePAC is contractually obligated to provide the Town of Rehoboth ("Rehoboth") only one copy of said recorded public meeting. Please recall that said public meeting contained references to matters that could be ripe for judicial review on behalf of parties who participated in said public meeting.

As noted in RePAC's recent Annual Report, published on June 15, 2011, at page 17, RePAC is always delighted to render duplication services of its archived recordings for a modest charge. The charge for each additional copy of the July 12, 2011, public meeting is twenty dollars (\$20.00). In light of a potential judicial review of the subject matters heard at said BOS public meeting, the charge for each true attested copy is forty dollars (\$40.00). In the event that you choose to order additional copies of said public meeting, please complete a formal request form and submit it to RePAC via U.S. Postal Service at P.O. Box 617, Rehoboth, MA 02769.

As a parenthetical side note, RePAC in the past encountered difficulties in collecting debts for duplication and attestation services rendered for attorneys who intended to use RePAC's archived recordings for litigation purposes. Thus, for the sake of avoiding the uncomfortable foreseeable ambiguity of a debt collection process, RePAC expects pre-payment from Rehoboth, by cashier check, for all duplication and attestation services rendered hereunder.
