Dear Mr. Vadnais:


I am in receipt of your notice dated November 13, 2009, of a scheduled consultation between the Board of Selectmen and its attorney on November 23, 2009. Unfortunately, I will not be available on that date because of prior commitments. In light of potential legal conflicts of interest, it would be unfair for RePAC to participate in a conference where the legal fees are paid by the Town of Rehoboth for the Board of Selectmen's attorney. RePAC has retained counsel for its own legal matters.

On several occasions, you received written requests concerning the formality necessary to activate the Public Access Channel 98 for integration with RePAC's operational Government Access Channel 9 and Educational Access Channel 15. According to Comcast Corporation, a formal written request for the activation of Public Access Channel 98 is required. Perhaps, this issue could comprise your agenda at your scheduled legal consultation on November 23, 2009. Once Public Access Channel 98 is activated, Rehoboth residents and agencies would have public access to RePAC's operation within the meaning of its By-Laws and Articles of Organization. Please see attached Annual Report.

Recall, on October 8, 2009, RePAC's Board of Directors invited the Board of Selectmen to a meeting at its studio during the week of October 12, 2009 (Certified Mail: 7008 0500 0001 0567 6229). Unfortunately, the Board of Selectmen chose to ignore the invitation. RePAC's Board of Directors again cordially invites the Board of Selectmen to meet with us during the week of December 7, 2009, at the RePAC studio to discuss any relevant matter and, in particular, the activation of the Public Access Channel 98.
