The Public Access Channel (Channel 98) has now been activated and is available for regular RePAC programming and broadcasting. Programs on Channel 98 will include the Dighton-Rehoboth Regional High School ("D-R") sport events and other extracurricular school activities that are not part of the D-R academic curriculum. Thus, effective October 4, 2010, Channel 98 will be structured to allow the Educational Access Channel 15 to focus on, and be exclusively available for, programs having material and relevant academic and educational value.

RePAC suggests that the D-R sport events and other extracurricular school activities, including graduation ceremonies, concerts, theatrical performances, student interviews, or chess tournaments, be taped and recorded by properly trained student volunteers or by students who are enrolled in an audio/visual aids course at D-R. This volunteer arrangement offers the D-R coaching staff and faculty an opportunity to train, schedule, and supervise their students during the taping and recording of the particular sport event or extracurricular school activity that D-R intends RePAC to broadcast on its Public Access Channel 98.

RePAC expects that the student productions of the sport events or the extracurricular activities will be digital recordings (DVD). D-R representatives can submit a copy of such a completed DVD to the RePAC studio at 320 Anawan Street, Rehoboth, MA 02769, for future broadcasting on Channel 98. To assure that all persons receive proper credit for their work, each such DVD shall unambiguously **identify**: **a)** the person(s) who recorded the sport event or the extracurricular school activity; **b)** the sport event or the extracurricular school activity which is recorded on the DVD; **c)** the date on which the sport event or the extracurricular school activity occurred and was recorded; **d)** the coaching staff or the faculty member(s) who supervised the recording of the sport event or the extracurricular school activity; **e)** the exact location where the recording of the sport event or the extracurricular school activity was performed; and **f)** the person(s) who performed the editing, if any, the final review, and the final approval of the entire content of the DVD recording. Please print the running time of the event on the DVD. RePAC shall retain such DVD at its studio until all broadcasting is complete or, if requested by D-R, shall archive it as a reference.
