Re.: Activation of Public Access Channel For Broadcasting Your Recordings of Public Interest.

Dear Mr. O'Connell:

On December 29, 2009, Ms. Maureen Brawley arranged a telephone conference (at 617-522-0049) concerning the broadcasting of five DVD recordings that you produced for *Life Matters*. More particularly, your productions are titled as:


1. Joy of Parenting and Happiness;
2. World Congress of Families;
3. Human Life International;
4. President of Breast Cancer Institute; and
5. Breast Cancer Surgeon/Prevention Institute.

Pursuant to our discussion, *Life Matters* is a weekly right-to-life program transmitted over Public Access Channels in several communities and originates at the Boston Neighborhood Network. Its purpose is to advance the right-to-life movement by discussing controversies that include the possible correlation between abortion and breast cancer and other contentious matters dealing with contraception, fertility, and sexually transmitted diseases. Sadly, Rehoboth's Public Access Channel (98) is not activated at this time and is, therefore, unavailable at the RePAC studio for broadcasting your DVD recordings that you produced for *Life Matters*.

The Board of Selectmen ("BOS") have been repeatedly reminded that the activation of the Public Access Channel involves a simple formal written request, initiated by the BOS, to Comcast Corporation. To date, the BOS has ignored this function. Therefore, RePAC has engineered an alternative means of transmitting your DVD recordings over the internet, via RePAC's website at <http://www.repac9.org>, by Video-on-Demand (VOD) access at its "Archives" link. Once you provide RePAC with a copyright release, RePAC can proceed with the required editorial review and transmit your productions via RePAC's VOD.
