

On July 1, 2010, Rehoboth Public Access Corporation (“RePAC”) recorded the proceedings of the Finance Committee and the Energy Committee public meetings. In light of the simultaneously scheduled public meetings, RePAC televised the Energy Committee meeting live on the Government Access Channel (9), i.e., the meeting was broadcasted in real time, and said recorded Finance Committee meeting was broadcasted several days later on Access Channel 9.

On July 6, 2010, Ms. Susan Pimental, chairlady of the Finance Committee, claimed superior standing in the performance of the Town’s business, *viz.*, finances, as “being of the utmost priority”, and relegated the activity of the Energy Committee, chaired by Mr. David House, to an inferior status. Thus, Ms. Pimental urges RePAC to share the opinion of her superiority and priority and to televise her performance at the Finance Committee meetings in real time. RePAC’s Board of Directors have neither the training nor the expertise to fairly judge or diagnose Ms. Pimental’s claims of superiority and priority concerning her conduct of the Town’s business. RePAC always strives to provide the public equal access to its resources; RePAC respectfully declines to make the uncomfortable determination as to the superiority or inferiority of the various Town Boards, Committees, and Commissions.

Thus, commencing on Monday, July 12, 2010, RePAC shall continue to record Board, Committee, and Commission public meetings but, with the exception of the Board of Selectmen public meetings, Town Meetings, and School Committee public meetings, all such public meetings shall not be broadcasted or televised in real time and shall be broadcasted or televised at a later date on the Government Access Channel (9).
