Pursuant to your letter dated March 3, 2010 (Certified Mail 7009 0080 0001 5916 8688), be advised that Rehoboth Public Access Corporation ("REPAC") is pleased to inform you that your membership for RePAC will be available once the Public Access Channel has been activated and is operational. It appears from your writing that you had some helpful and fruitful discussions with Selectman Kevin McBride concerning his agenda to assist the residents in the installation of the Public Access Channel for the Rehoboth community. I hope Selectman McBride will be successful in persuading Comcast of Massachusetts I, Inc., i.e., Comcast Cable, to activate the Public Access Channel as soon as possible so that your membership application can be expedited.

Until then, a great deal of volunteer work is available as part of RePAC's service and operation of the Government Access Channel and the Educational Access Channel.
