Ms. Auclair:

Pursuant to a letter, authored by David J. Marciello, dated March 16, 2010, a request was made to broadcast one of your productions, concerning a Saint Anne's Hospital event, on the Rehoboth Government Access Channel 9 (see attached letter). Please recall that on March 11, 2010, Mr. Ed Schagrin explained to you that Rehoboth Public Access Corporation ("REPAC") does not have available a Public Access Channel to broadcast important public programs such as your production having socially redeeming values. In April 2004, Comcast Cable had an obligation and opportunity to install the Public Access Channel for Rehoboth but refused to do so. Since then, RePAC has repeatedly requested the Board of Selectmen and David J. Marciello to activate the Public Access Channel for Rehoboth public use but they also refused to do so. As a result, an uncomfortable situation was created where RePAC has now requested the Bristol County Superior Court to clarify the rights of all parties. Mr. Marciello is named a co-defendant in an action related to the refusal to make a Public Access Channel available for Rehoboth residents, public agencies, elected officials, and groups such as Oliveira Creative Group. (See RePAC v. Town of Rehoboth, Comcast, Board of Selectmen, et al., Case BRCV2010-00353-C).

Until the legal matter, concerning the availability of a Public Access Channel for Rehoboth is resolved in the Superior Court, RePAC would be delighted to broadcast your program on its website at [www.repac9.org](http://www.repac9.org), as originally suggested by Mr. Schagrin.
