

Please take notice that Rehoboth Public Access Corporation (hereinafter "RePAC"), by and through its Board of Directors, hereby formally opposes the adoption of any and all amendments, including the adoption of any request for amendment(s), change(s), or alteration(s) to Article 6, Section 6.3, concerning the Cable Television Renewal License, executed on March 29, 2004, effective April 10, 2004 and to expire on April 9, 2014, between the Town of Rehoboth and Comcast of Massachusetts I, Inc.. In support therefor, RePAC submits a petition of two-hundred thirty-eight (238) signatories stating that they are satisfied with the operation of RePAC and respectfully request the Public Access Channel be activated so that Rehoboth's residents may have public access.

In further support of RePAC's notice in opposition to the proposed amending process addressed to the Town of Rehoboth, RePAC incorporates herein by reference the following pleadings being part of the pending litigation in the matter of *Rehoboth Public Access Corporation v. Town of Rehoboth, et al.*, Bristol Superior Court BRCV2010-00353-C:

1. Complaint, served upon the Town Clerk on March 19, 2010; and
2. Plaintiff's Motion For Injunctive Relief, served upon the Town Clerk on March 29, 2010, pursuant to Superior Court Rule 9A.

This notice of opposition to the Keeper of the Record is intended to be included in the record of the Town of Rehoboth proceeding concerning any amending of said Cable Television Renewal License on or about April 1, 2010, or at any time thereafter.
